

NOTICE TO ELECTORS

Re: 2018 Municipal & School Board Election (Telephone / Internet Voting)

Electors of the Town of Fort Frances and those who own property in Fort Frances should receive their Voter Information Letter by the end of September.

The Voter Information Letter mailed to each elector will contain your Personal Identification Number (PIN), the telephone number to call to cast your vote and the designated internet address to access to cast a vote using the internet. Also included will be instructions on how to vote, dates and hours of voting, location of the Voter Help Centre and a list of who you are eligible to vote for.

If you do not receive your Voter Information Letter in the mail by October 10, 2018, and you wish to vote, please attend the Voter Help Centre for assistance. Please ensure that you bring acceptable ID. The Voter Help Centre will be open during normal business hours beginning Monday October 15, 2018 to Friday October 19, 2018 and again on Voting Day, Monday October 22, 2018 from 10am to 8pm.

The Telephone / Internet Voting system will be activated at 8:30 am on Monday October 15, 2018 and will deactivate at 8:00 pm on Monday October 22, 2018. Access to the system is available 24 hours a day during that period.
